<p>1) General Discussion</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Senator Manning <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Formerly Police Commissioner - 6yrs b. Then EWEB Commissioner - no increase in utilities or water cost to customers during his service c. Currently board member of Planned Parenthood d. Currently District 7 Rep (Whit, Bethel, Santa Clara, Bethel, J-City) e. Running 2018 for a full term (called “Champion of the Underdog” by his peers) f. Has co-sponsored over 100 pieces of legislation, examples <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Equal Pay Act ii. Cover All Kids (over 400K children covered by OHP) iii. Health Care for All (sponsored, but wasn’t passed, will continue to push in 2018; adds healthcare for 350K children, elders, and legal immigrants) g. Measure 101 - urges us to help him pass this: saves healthcare access for Oregon’s most vulnerable h. “Affordable housing” - he wants to talk about medium to low income housing with more options to buy i. Invitation to visit him at the capitol; he will take people out on the Senate floor; he will sit for coffee j. New Day, Dec 20th at 9am k. Question: Are you familiar with State agencies that oversee Research Extraction? WCC member is concerned that fines are not being enforced.
