Process Questions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Illegal activity needs to be witnessed by officer to have action taken 2. Civilian eyewitness can be used to formulate plan, strategy, but can't stand alone for police action 3. Possession of drugs = misdemeanor 4. Certain violations funnel you into community court 5. If a person has a bad experience with dispatcher can make complaint by just reporting time you called and what the issue was about <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. All calls are recorded and with this information the auditors can look back and listen to calls b. Supervisor at dispatch (call dispatch center and ask for a supervisor to file a complaint) c. Auditor- but supervisor will be more effective 6. Community service officers (not real police officer) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. When there is no bad guy around b.
